What is the Switchover?

The digital switchover is the change from analogue signals to digital signals throughout the whole of the UK

What does this mean for me?

It means that any Television that does not use a digital signal will not be able to view TV channels!

How do I get digital?

You can get digital television through an aerial, satellite dish, cable or phone line

To view the Channels what equipment do I need for the switchover?

You do not need to replace your television, but you will need some extra equipment to connect to it

What equipment is this then?

For digital terrestrial TV

- You will need a digital set-top box or a new television with integrated digital TV
- You may also need to upgrade your aerial to receive a digital signal

For digital satellite TV

- You will need a satellite receiver and dish

For digital cable TV

- A cable company supplies a connection to a cable system and decoder box. Not currently available in the Highlands & Islands

When does the Switchover happen in the Highlands & Islands?

Switchover is happening throughout the UK between 2008 and 2012. The Highland & Islands switchover will take place in 2010
